What is the process?

Once the applications are in there will be a decision if the course runs. If there is enough student interest then an interview process in May and students will know if they are in the program by June.

There is a cost associated with each course.

Course expenses are for items students take away with them at the end of the course include the following:

Pro-Cook: Uniform

Carpentry: Visual Vest, Workbook, tool belt and tools Automotive Technician: Overalls and resource books

We are awaiting the exact cost and will provide that once the applicant has been accepted to the program.

To help with budgeting, 2023 costs were Pro-Cook fees were \$100 plus \$100 deposit for knife kit (this will be returned if the kits are returned without missing equipment), Carpentry \$460 and Automotive \$650. We expect the costs to go up slightly for the next year.
