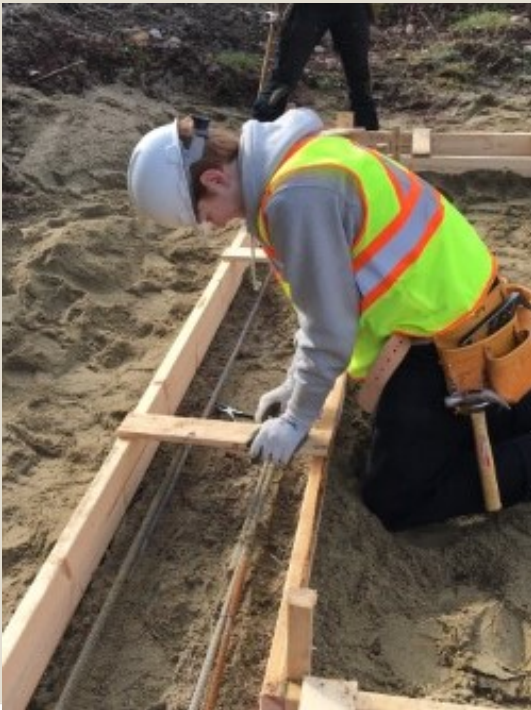

Overview

Process: to apply

- Students are to fill in Application Packages that are available tonight or at the schools Counsellor office.
- **MUST BE COMPLETED AND HANDED INTO THE COUNSILLOR BY**
- **MARCH 15.**

- Students will get in the package or can download form SD#46 website and print off a study package for the Vancouver Island University entrance exam.

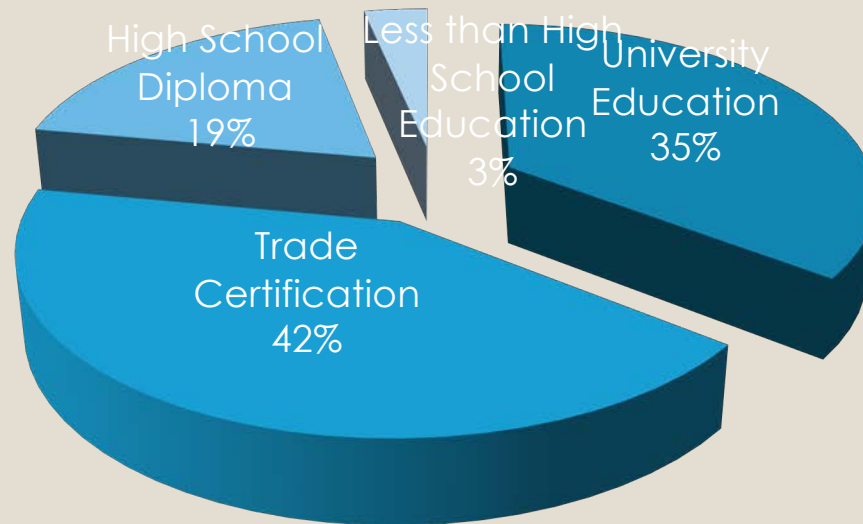
- The students for all areas will write the exam **April 10.**
- **Students need 70% to pass.**

When are they confirmed a spot?

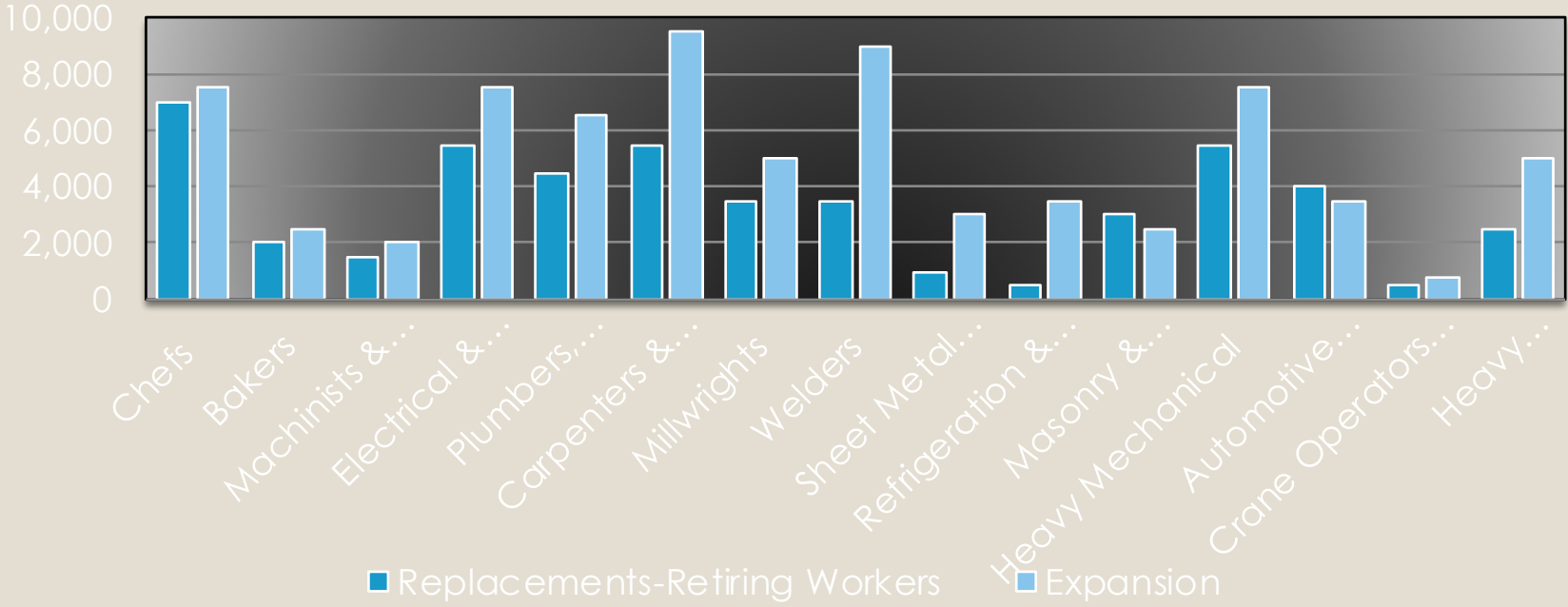
After the Entrance Exam and if they get over 70%

- Students will receive by mail and an email a confirmation that they are on the program list and at this time a non-refundable registration fee that is for supplies will be asked for to guarantee them a spot. This year the fee was \$550 and it pays for uniforms, textbooks everything the students can take home with them after the course.
- In the case of class size over the min. an interview process may occur and the career path sheet will be considered.

- Hours to go towards Level One. Please note most Level 1 Trades require 1000 hours of Technical and work hours. Our Train in Trades Courses give the students **just under half of the required level one hours.**

What if the student doesn't know if this is the right career for them?

- The School District has bought the career program called myblueprint.ca/sd46 the careers teachers may have used this program and the students fill in 5 surveys finding out learning styles, personality, interests, knowledge and motivation on **Who Am I?** and after they do this suggested occupations will be pop up.
- Parents can use this with their son/daughters to find careers they are interested in.
- Courses are listed and post secondary schools and jobs!

What is next?

- **Complete the application package and hand into Counsellor by March 15.**
- **VIU entrance test. April 10**
- **Parent meeting to meet the Instructors before the course starts.**

Work In Trade is after Train in Trades and the students work and earn hours towards level 1 completion.
