Students earn graduation credits and may earn post secondary credits.

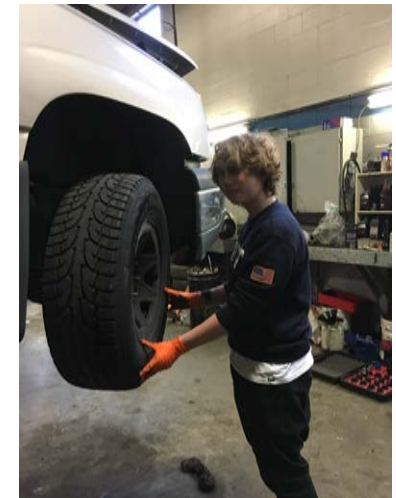

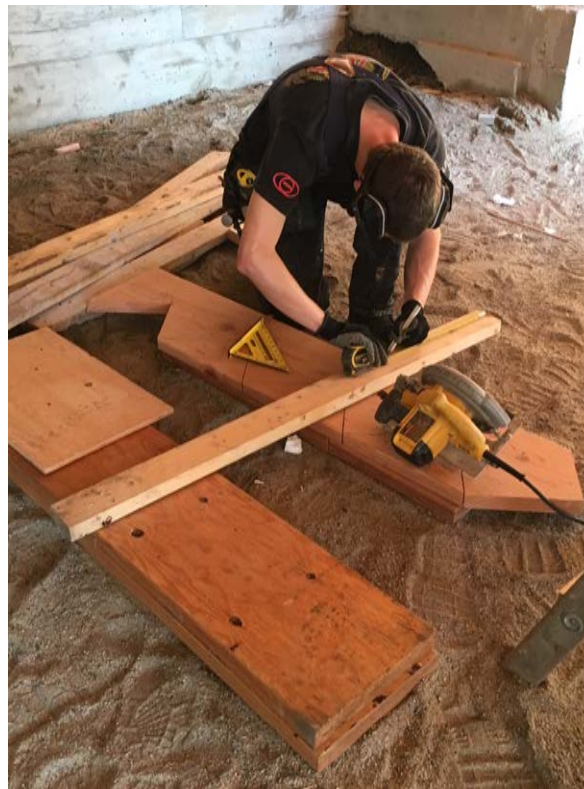
WORK EXPERIENCE 12A/12B

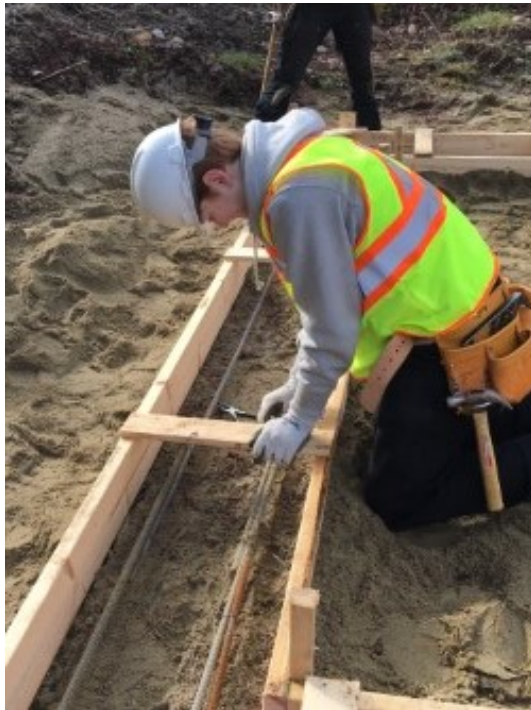

CARPENTRY 16 CREDITS SECOND SEMESTER (FEB.) APPRENTICESHIP # AND VIU





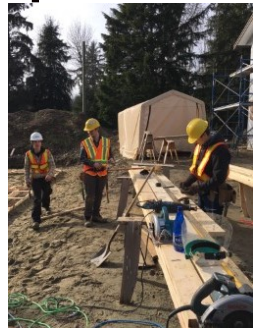
WHAT IF THE STUDENT DOESN'T KNOW IF THIS IS THE RIGHT CAREER FOR THEM?

- The School District has bought the career program called myblueprint.ca/sd46 the careers teachers may have used this program and the students fill in 5 surveys finding out learning styles, personality, interests, knowledge and motivation on **Who Am I?** and after they do this suggested occupations will be pop up.
- Parents can use this with their son/daughters to find careers they are interested in.
- Courses are listed and post secondary schools and jobs!



YOUTH WORK IN TRADES

- The students work in one of the Industry Training Authority Apprenticeships (ITA) and earn hours towards level 1 completion.
Students earn 4 school credits for every 120 hours worked up to 16 credits towards graduation.
- There is a B.C. Gov. Scholarship available:
1000 hours of work, Graduate,
C+ average in Grade 12 courses
Completion of Youth Work in Trades (480 hours) courses: 11A, 11B, 12A, 12B
